We welcome Bruno Ehrs as a new photographer to Link Image.

Bruno Ehrs began as an architectural photographer at Stockholm City Museum under the wing of legendary photographer Lennart af Petersens. Bruno gradually progressed to become photographer for Bonniers magazines where he worked a couple of years on *Vecko Revyn* and *Månadsjournalen*. His breakthrough came with the book and exhibition *Stockholmssviten* displayed at the Modern Museum in Stockholm. An affectionate, modern monochrome depiction of Stockholm with music by Tom Wolgers from 1987. Since then we have met Bruno's characteristic style with clear references to classic photography in widely differing contexts. His architectural photographs radiate more than just perspective and construction, his travel images exude culture and presence, and his portraits reach deep into the personality of the subject. One of his most famous portraits is of the Swedish King, sunbathing at a quayside in Stockholm, from the *Stockholm to Close* exhibition.

Today Bruno gladly takes on advertising and company presentation assignments. He currently has assignments for companies like NCC, Vattenfall,

SEB, Boliden, Green Cargo, AP among others. He also works on a continuous basis for magazines like RES, Gourmet and Plaza.
